

Report Criteria

- Your report must be DOUBLE SPACED and typed in a font no larger than 14.
- No funky, curly, cursive fonts that are hard to read.
- The final draft of the report must be free of spelling and grammatical errors!
- You need to create and turn in at least one edited rough draft.
- The report needs to have a bibliography. This is a list of the books and websites you used to get your information.
- Your report must be in paragraph form. It needs to have the following information:

- Date and place the scientist was born
- Information about his or her childhood
- Information about his or her education
- Was he or she married? Did he or she have children?
- What kind of jobs did he or she have?
- What did he or she invent or make? When?
- What kind of impact did the inventions have on the world?
- When did he or she die and how?
